**PUBLIC RELEASE RE MATTER OF PUBLIC IMPORT — BEASTYC10**

I can confirm an investigation into reports of bribery and corruption has been conducted into Congressman Beastyc10. Investigators conducted a thorough analysis of evidence provided and collected witness statements over a lengthy period of time.

Investigators concluded that no admissible evidence existed to suggest that a Criminal Offending had occurred under the 18<sup>th</sup> Title of the United States Code, and the discourse surrounding the evidence collected from witness statements provided reasonable doubt about the integrity of the evidence provided.

This matter has cemented the importance of Court Admissibility rules in Agents of the Bureau and of members of the Department of Justice alike.

I can confirm that the investigation into the Congressman has now concluded and that no charges will be recommended to the Department of Justice.
